Our initial 499 effort was a success with 36 attendees expertly hosted by Joe Hertz, a longtime NVBA 199/499 director. The next NVBA online 499er game is this Tuesday, July 30 at 7:00PM. This 499er game is run on BBO using the SE Carolina Club of Clubs platform. While the 499 game is open to any BBO player, we expect most players to be NVBA members. Joe Hertz will again direct that game. To NVBA members playing in other ACBL online 499 evening games, please consider our new 499 game on Tuesday night and help us bring back the Golden Age of the friendly NVBA 199/499er games with folks you know.

**What:** NVBA and SE Carolina (SEC) host a 499 Game with NVBA Director [Joe Hertz](#), cost is \$5 for 18 Boards

**Why:** Come play with other NVBA 499ers you know - and also support NVBA as \$2.00 per NVBA participant is shared with NVBA. While this BBO game is open to all BBO members – we anticipate most players will be NVBA 499ers.

**When:** Tuesday - July 30 @7:00PM

**Where:** Go to BBO Online: 1) then select “Virtual Clubs”, 2) then “ACBL-North America”, then select 3) “SE Carolina”. It should specify 7:00, 499er Game. You should be able to sign on with your partner. If you need a partner, BBO has a partnership feature on all pair games.

All can play in any [SE Carolina Club of Clubs](#) game. They also offer daily 0-750, 0-2500, and Open games. This benefits NVBA as we are a member club. We get two dollars for each NVBA player buying an entry to this club game. The more people that play online in this game the more money we earn. - **Supervised Play nears Critical Mass**
  - A "Faithful Few" have enjoyed Supervised Play Thursday Evenings at Beth El throughout July since the Reston Regional
  - All of them are eager to continue, but this event will morph into a two-table 0-20 or 0-50 Newcomer Game once we have eight players
  - Between "0-5 always play free at NVBA events," Entry Fee for Newcomer Game is only \$5," and "We won't start any boards after 8:50PM," expect any Newcomer Game
    - to play 6-8 hands in about 90 -105 minutes
    - to provide an opportunity for players to ask questions and receive answers during the auction and the play
    - to cost players \$2 (Beth El Security Fee) to \$7 (add \$5 entry fee once you achieve 5 ACBL Masterpoints)
  - Fewer than 8 players? same Supervised Play as usual, hope for more players next Thursday
